All fees are subject to change. All fees are inclusive of GST.

The following fees as listed shall be paid prior to processing by the Association of documents submitted:

1. Membership Fees

a) Full	\$176

2. Initial Breeding Fee

Payable in respect of all registered stallions born in Australia after 1st August 1979, prior to first service taking place. \$550

Payable in respect of all stallions imported after 1st August 1994, prior to first service taking place. \$550

Payable in respect of all recorded Foundation Stallions born in Australia after 1st August 1979, prior to first service taking place. \$550

Failure to have a stallion fully endorsed as having completed the IBF process prior to the first service taking place, penalty (in addition to IBF) \$2,200

From 1st August 2005, the IBF process must also be completed for foundation stallions.

3. Breeding Returns

For Breeding Returns lodged by the due dates as contained in Rule 25.1, fee per certificate payable by stallion owner.	\$20
For Breeding Returns lodged within three (3) months of the due dates as contained in Rule 25.1	\$40
For Breeding Returns over three (3) months past due date.	\$132

Note: Stallion owners lodging Breeding Returns later than three (3) months after the due dates Rule 25.1 will not have such certificates accepted automatically.

Failure to keep stallion records up to date for more than 12 months – penalty fee Rule 25.1 \$1100
